Kami harap URDI dapat terus berkontribusi dalam pembangunan perkotaan dan daerah di Indonesia.



# TENTANG URDI

## ABOUT URDI

**Urban and Regional Development Institute (URDI)** adalah organisasi nirlaba independen yang bertujuan untuk mempromosikan pembangunan perkotaan dan regional yang berkelanjutan di Indonesia. Lembaga ini memiliki organisasi inti yang relatif kecil dan pada saat yang sama terus mengembangkan jaringan organisasi yang luas.

Lembaga ini telah bekerja sama dengan berbagai mitra mulai dari pemerintah daerah hingga pemerintah pusat, sektor swasta, dan berbagai lembaga internasional. Lembaga ini secara konsisten berupaya mendukung peningkatan kapasitas lokal melalui program pelatihan dengan menggunakan pendekatan inovatif.

## LATAR BELAKANG

Pembangunan perkotaan dan regional di Indonesia telah lama ditandai dengan semakin lebarnya kesenjangan antara kebijakan yang bertujuan baik dan tindakan yang dilaksanakan secara buruk, antara penelitian yang ekstensif dan praktik yang tidak terintegrasi, antara apa yang sebenarnya dibutuhkan dan apa yang sebenarnya disediakan. Ada juga perbedaan kepentingan yang besar di antara para pemangku kepentingan dalam pembangunan daerah yang terus menerus mengancam terhambatnya pembangunan.

**Urban and Regional Development Institute (URDI)** is an independent not-for-profit organization aimed at promoting sustainable urban and regional development in Indonesia. The institute maintains a relatively small core organization while at the same time continuously developing an expansive networking organization.

The institute has worked with a wide range of partners from local government to national government, private sectors, and various international agencies. The institute consistently supports local capacity building through training programs using innovative approaches.

## HISTORY

Urban and regional development in Indonesia has long been characterized by widening gaps between well-intentioned policies and poorly implemented actions, between extensive research and un-integrated practice, and between what is needed and what is provided. There has also been a considerable divergence of interests among the stakeholders in local development that continuously threatens to put the development on the brakes.

Berlatar belakang itulah **Yayasan Pengembangan Perkotaan dan Daerah atau URDI** mendirikan lembaga independen ini pada bulan November 1995. Dengan misi tersebut, URDI didirikan dan terus didukung oleh pihak-pihak yang peduli dari berbagai sektor pembangunan perkotaan dan daerah. masyarakat yang mewakili pemerintah, swasta dan masyarakat. Sejak didirikan, lembaga ini terus berupaya menangani berbagai isu pembangunan perkotaan dan regional baik pada tingkat kebijakan maupun program peningkatan kapasitas.

*Such a situation has been compounded by the current trends of rapidly increasing urbanization, economic as well as socio-cultural globalization, decentralization of authorities, democratization of governance, widespread privatization, and the like. The limited and unevenly allocated natural, social, financial, physical, and human resources among localities in Indonesia have made the task of improving the people's welfare through urban and regional development even more challenging.*

*It is with such a backdrop that the **Yayasan Pengembangan Perkotaan dan Daerah or URDI Foundation** set up this independent institution in November 1995. With the aforesaid missions, URDI was founded and is continuously supported by concerned people from various segments of the urban and regional development community representing the government, private, and community sectors. Since its establishment, the institute continuously works on various urban and regional development issues both at the policy level and capacity building program.*





# STRATEGIC POLICY FEEDING ROAD TO PARIS AND TRACEABILITY OF INDONESIA INDC

OCTOBER 2015 – JUNE 2016

Komitmen Indonesia untuk mendukung mengatasi dampak perubahan iklim tertuang pertama kali dalam dokumen NDC (Nationally Determined Contribution) pada tahun 2015. Dalam konteks ini, URDI telah mendukung penyusunan dokumen NDC tersebut dengan memberikan masukan-masukan strategis terkait penanganan perubahan iklim yang terutama terdampak oleh masifnya perubahan tata guna lahan Indonesia dari guna lahan konservasi menjadi guna lahan budidaya.

*Indonesia's commitment to support overcoming the impacts of climate change was first stated in the NDC (Nationally Determined Contribution) document in 2015. In this context, URDI has supported the preparation of the NDC document by providing strategic input regarding handling climate change which is especially affected by massive changes. Indonesia's land use from conservation land use to cultivation land use.*

# EXPANDING COMMUNITY RIGHTS, LIVELIHOODS INNOVATION & REDD+ IN INDONESIA

APRIL 2021 - MARCH 2025

Indonesia masuk dalam daftar 10 besar negara penghasil emisi gas rumah kaca di dunia dan memiliki kemampuan besar dalam penyerapan karbon dan memberikan kesejahteraan.

PERMATA merupakan inisiatif yang bertujuan mendukung pengakuan hak-hak Masyarakat Adat dan Komunitas Lokal (MAKL) yang tinggal di dalam dan sekitar kawasan hutan untuk mendapatkan penghidupan berkelanjutan serta memperbaiki tata kelola sektor hutan dan lahan yang lestari dalam mengatasi masalah deforestasi dan degradasi hutan di Indonesia.

PERMATA bekerja di 6 kabupaten yang berada di wilayah Provinsi Papua (Kabupaten Jayapura dan Merauke), Provinsi Papua Barat (Kabupaten Tambrauw dan Teluk Bintuni), Provinsi Kalimantan Utara (Kabupaten Malinau) dan Provinsi Kalimantan Barat (Kabupaten Kapuas Hulu).

*Indonesia is included in the list of the top 10 greenhouse gas emitting countries in the world but has a great ability to absorb carbon and provide welfare for the customary community and their local communities.*

*PERMATA is an initiative that aims to support the recognition of the rights of Indigenous People and Local Communities (IPLC) who live in and around forest areas to obtain sustainable livelihoods and improve sustainable forest and land sector management in overcoming the problem of deforestation and forest degradation in Indonesia.*

*PERMATA works in 6 regencies located in Papua Province (Jayapura regency and Merauke regency), West Papua Province (Tambrauw regency and Teluk Bintuni regency), North Kalimantan Province (Malinau regency) and West Kalimantan Province (Kapuas Hulu regency).*



# STUDY ON SPATIAL AND LAND USE PLANNING RELATED TO LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCE CONFLICT

*SEPTEMBER 2017 – MARCH 2018*

Investasi berbasis lahan skala besar di berbagai penjuru Indonesia berdampak pada timbulnya konflik terhadap penggunaan lahan dan sumber daya alam. Hasil dari kajian ini memperlihatkan bahwa walaupun kebijakan tata ruang sudah berupaya untuk mengatur pemanfaatan lahan berwawasan lingkungan, akan tetapi dalam pelaksanaannya masih tidak konsisten sehingga aturan tata ruang justru berdampak pada timbulnya permasalahan penggunaan lahan.

*Large-scale land-based investments in various parts of Indonesia have resulted in conflicts over the use of land and natural resources. The results of this study showed despite spatial planning policies attempting to regulate sustainable land use, its implementation is still inconsistent thus the spatial plan inflicted the emergence of land use conflict.*

*Population dynamics is one of the main factors that need to be considered in analyzing the impacts of climate change. In order to increase the likelihood of sustainable development (more particularly national and sub-national development planning) through systematically linking issues of population dynamics, climate change adaptation, and disaster risk reduction and integrating both concepts into all levels of the sustainable development processes.*


Gagasan utama dari studi ini adalah untuk meningkatkan pengelolaan sampah dengan membentuk lembaga-lembaga baru yang lebih kuat dan lebih gesit dan mandiri. Ide tersebut diwujudkan melalui penerapan Badan Pelayanan Unit Daerah (BLUD) dalam pengelolaan sampah di Kabupaten Malang.

Dalam rangka mendukung penyusunan strategi pengembangan BLUD Pelayanan Persampahan di Kabupaten Malang, URDI mencoba menelaah bagaimana kesiapan regulasi persampahan dan efektivitas pelaksanaannya, serta bagaimana persepsi para pemangku kepentingan kunci untuk mendukung sistem BLUD Pelayanan Persampahan di Kabupaten Malang.

*Insufficient waste system funding, inadequate governance, and lack of technical capacity to build and operate waste systems in a sustainable manner are the main factors underlying the low level of waste handling in Indonesia.*

*The main idea of the study is to enhance waste management by installing a new strong institution that is more agile and independent. This idea is carried out by implementing Badan Layanan Unit Daerah (BLUD) on waste management in Malang Regency.*

*In order to support the preparation of a strategy for developing the Waste Service BLUD in Malang Regency, URDI is trying to examine how prepared waste preparation is and the effectiveness of its implementation, as well as the perceptions of stakeholders to support the Waste Service BLUD system in Malang Regency.*
